- 5. Supported the 2018 application for a Regional Cumberland to Timucuan Trail designation by Florida's Department of Greenways and Trails. This designation will increase our priority for future Florida SUN trails grant funding.
- 6. Supported bicycle safety education through the Fernandina Beach Police Department over multiple years.
- 7. Continued to maintain the Egans Creek Greenway Trail System and encourage bicycling in Fernandina Beach.
